What is aggression?

Aggression is any mean look, gesture, word or action that hurts a person's body, feelings, friendships and reputation, or property.

Student to Student Aggression Rubric

<p>► Level 1 Hurtful Action or Behavior</p> <p>Unkind gestures or looks Name calling Insulting/sarcastic remarks Excluding others Behaviors that hurt feelings Swearing Horseplay, cutting in line</p>	<p>1st–4th Time</p> <p>Consequences range from 15 second intervention to Wednesday detention</p>
<p>► Level 2 Disrespectful behavior</p> <p>Moderate physical contact</p> <p>pushing, hitting grabbing, pinching swearing, tripping</p>	<p>1st–4th Time</p> <p>Consequences range from 15 second intervention w/ a 1hr detention to 1 Day out of school suspension</p>
<p>► Level 3 Intimidation/Harrasment</p> <p>Threatening Behavior Severe physical contact</p> <p>fighting, punching biting, choking spitting, racial ethnic, sexual, or religious</p>	<p>1st–4th Time</p> <p>Consequences range from 1-3 day in/out of school suspension to 10 day out of school suspension</p>

Note: At the discretion of the administrator, consequences assigned may be more severe in any above category based on the seriousness of the action.
